



COMMANDER NIGHTS: *WILDS OF ELDRAINE*

Complete achievements from the list below to win special prizes. When you've checked off [], present the list to your organizer for a reward. Once you've completed [], present your list again for an even better prize.

Special Rules (Optional):

- **September 15 – September 21:** The first time each turn you create a Role token attached to a creature, create a copy of that Role attached to another creature you control.
- **September 29 – October 5:** Whenever a creature you control enchanted by a Role dies, you may create a copy of that Role attached to a creature you control that does not already have an enchantment attached to it.
- **October 13 – October 19:** The first time a player casts a commander each turn, that player may tap target creature and put a stun counter on it.

Achievements:

- ☐ **Simply Enchanting:** Control five or more enchanted permanents.
- ☐ **Magical Tricksters:** Activate or trigger the abilities of three or more creatures you control in a single turn.
- ☐ **Role with the Punches:** Deal combat damage to an opponent with a commander enchanted by a Role..
- ☐ **Smorgasbord:** Have a total of three or more differently named Food in your graveyard and/or on the battlefield under your control.
- ☐ **Time for Another Adventure:** Cast two Adventures in a single turn.
- ☐ **What a Bargain:** Cast two bargained spells in a single turn.
- ☐ **Noblesse Oblige:** Control a total of three or more Noble creatures and/or creatures enchanted by a Royal Role token. If you are the monarch, the required total is one less.
- ☐ **Grand Celebration:** Have eight or more nonland permanents enter the battlefield under your control in a single turn.
- ☐ **My Favorite Story:** Complete a Saga that shares a name with a Saga you've already completed that game.
- ☐ **Toil and Trouble:** Cast, trigger, or activate two or more spells or abilities in a single turn that include the word "double."
- ☐ **Court Champion:** Win a game with a monocolored commander.
